Kindergarten registration for the Granby Public Schools will take place on Monday, March 21 between 5-7 p.m. in the Kearns All-Purpose Room. Children who will be five years of age on or before January 1, 2017 must be registered for the 2016-2017 school year. Parents choosing not to enroll their eligible child for kindergarten must complete an option form exempting their child from school attendance. Children don't need to be present at registration.
